MARCH 15 LUNCHEON MEETING “WHAT ROLE WILL THE FEDERAL CIRCUIT PLAY IN PATENT REFORM?”

Kevin L. Reiner is Senior Counsel at Darby & Darby. He focuses his practice on patent prosecution, counseling and intellectual property litigation. He has represented a broad range of companies and individuals in a variety of technology areas, including mechanical and medical devices, pharmaceuticals and business methods.

Mr. Reiner will discuss how recent cases may portend what role the Federal Circuit will play in the current era of an active Supreme Court and calls for patent reform. The discussion will include issues that are both internal and external to the appeals court. Particular cases explored will include *Amgen Inc. v. Hoechst Marion Roussel, Inc.* (05-1157), *SmithKline Beecham v. Apotex* (04-1522), and *KSR, Inc. v. Teleflex, Inc.*, currently before the Supreme Court.

Mr. Reiner’s patent prosecution and counseling practice has involved such diversified technologies as radiological protection systems, biochemical sensors, automotive engines and transmission, surgical catheters, internet data transmission technologies, consumer hygiene goods, laser drilling systems, internet billing and payment systems, sewage and waste processing systems, garment and clothing technologies, optical analysis systems, diamond inscribing technologies, casting and metallurgical processes, scientific and industrial centrifuges, dental surgery and implant technologies, lumber and paper products, herbicidal compositions, metal alloys and composite materials, printing and embossing equipment, construction equipment and tools, industrial braiding technologies, and internet marketing systems.

Mr. Reiner practices extensively in all aspects of intellectual property litigation, from pre-filing investigation through trial and appeal. Notable cases include *Novozymes A/S v. Genencor Int'l, Inc. et al.*, 446 F.Supp. 2d 297 (D. Del. 2006), in which Mr. Reiner was third chair on the trial team that secured a patent infringement decision against a genetically-engineered starch processing enzyme used in the production of fuel ethanol from crops; *Concept Innovation Inc. v. CFM Corp. et al.* (N.D. Ill. 2005 - CA 04-3345), in which Mr. Reiner prosecuted a design patent and trade secret misappropriation action on behalf of a southeast Asian manufacturer against a Canadian competitor and negotiated a global IP settlement; *V.P. Intellectual Properties, L.L.C. v. Nobel Biocare USA, Inc. et al.* (D.N.J. 2003 - CA 99-3136), in which Mr. Reiner helped prosecute a patent infringement action involving dental implant technology against four major manufacturers that secured an over \$5 million settlement for the inventors; and *Allegiance Healthcare Corp. v. London Int'l Group Ltd. et al.* (N.D. Ga. 2002 - CA 89-1796), in which Mr. Reiner was a member of the trial and appeal team that successfully defended a medical device manufacturer at trial in a false advertising suit by a competitor and opposed the competitors' subsequent appeal to the Eleventh Circuit.

Prior to his legal career, Mr. Reiner was an engineer with Riley Stoker Corporation, a manufacturer of equipment for the power industry, and with Teledyne Engineering Services, an engineering consulting firm. He obtained his Professional Engineer license in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts in 1995.
